The modest entry of 3-2-2 (dogs, bitches, specials) represented one of the larger Ontario Elkhound entries in recent months.

With approximately 25 hounds present (including all six Dachshund breeds), Saturday's booster winner, Charlie MacInnes' Ch. The Canadian National will take place Saturday, July 14, 2007 with boosters Friday, July 13 and Sunday, July 15. The Specialty will be held in conjunction with the Oxford County Kennel Club shows, located at Woodstock, Ontario (between London and Toronto _ the same site as the 2003 NECC National). All Breed Obedience is offered. Oxford County is one of Canada's largest outdoor shows and a very popular one.

Pending CKC approval our Breed Judge is Mr. Ralf Campbell of Norway, and our Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes Judge is Mrs. Jean Whiting.

A block of rooms will be reserved at the Quality Inn, Woodstock ON, which will be our Host Hotel. Scheduled events include a Wine & Cheese party, Friday from 4:30-6 pm hosted by the NECC. We'll be getting together with old friends and welcoming new ones! The Banquet will be held at the host hotel, the Quality Inn, on Saturday and will include live entertainment and a silent auction.
